FLOWER MOSAIC

We will be making a mosaic for a special art project using different materials found at home. GATHER THESE MATERIALS AND BRING TO ART CLASS ON FRIDAY. We will be working together to create this artwork.

If you don't have the materials, you can use the items in the substitute list.

MATERIALS:

PAPER:

- Flower Printout on 8.5" x 11" Letter size paper or you can draw your own flower
- Cardboard backing from card stock or cardboard from cereal boxes, old folders, ends of old notebooks, or paper pads.

FOR THE MOSAIC:

- beans
- seeds
- pasta

If you don't have these materials, you can always substitute with any of these.

- sequins
- buttons
- colored paper cut into squares, triangles
- tissue paper cut in squares
- paper punch outs (using paper puncher)

ADHESIVE:

- Elmer's glue or Tacky glue (for beans, pasta, and buttons) or
- Glue stick for paper and other lighter materials

FOR DRAWING FLOWER AND STEMS:

- pencil to sketch the flower
- markers, paints, or crayons to outline and color the stems

Note: If you are thinking of drawing your own flower, please draw your flower in pencil in advance. Have it ready for art class.
