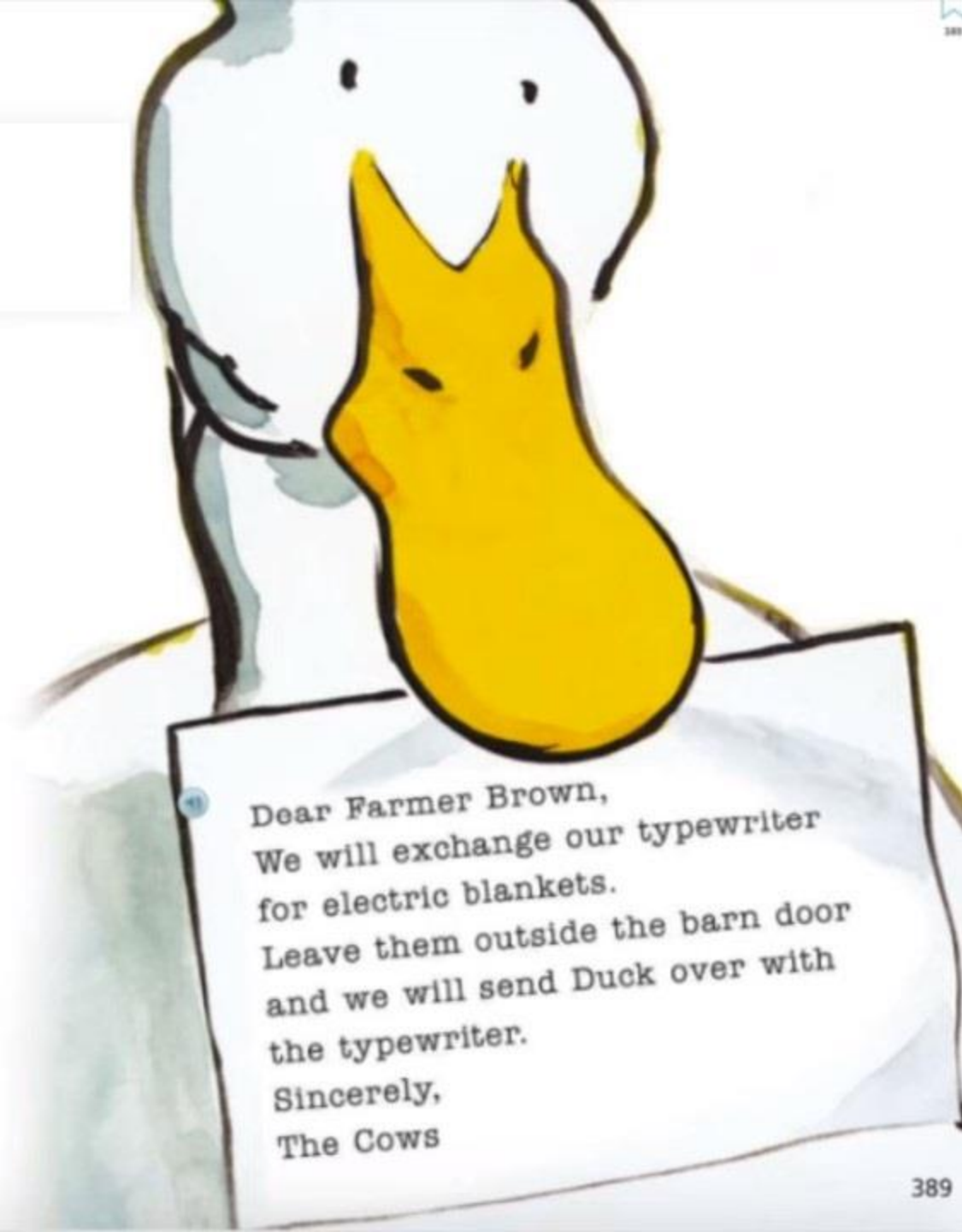
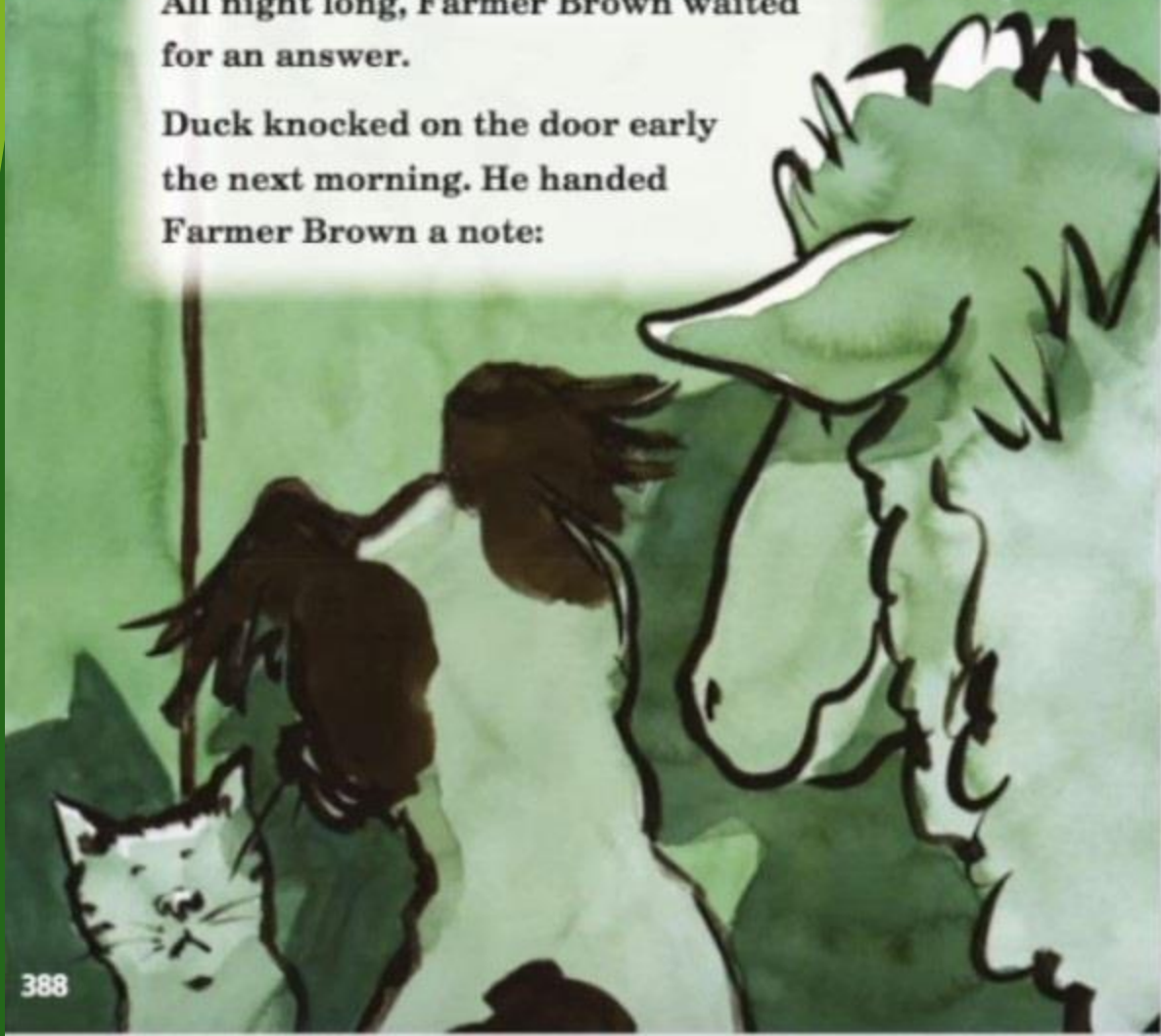


● Duck was a neutral party, so he brought the ultimatum to the cows.
